Discover for yourself the majesty and beauty
of Washington DC
over a long Spring weekend.

After lunch in Union Station, we go on to the colorful Adams Morgan entertainment/restaurant district for training in "right-brained" abstract photography, then to the magnificent Washington National Cathedral where we teach you how (and how not) to photograph church interiors and the most beautiful stained glass windows you will ever see in any church.



Our afternoon session ends at the famous 76-foot tall Iwo Jima Marine Corps Memorial in Arlington, where you can duplicate the famous photograph taken by AP photographer Joe Rosenthal on Mt. Suribachi in 1945 and capture in your camera each of the six soldiers depicted in Clint Eastwood's recent movie, *Flags of our Fathers*, against a backdrop of the Washington Monument and the US Capitol across the Potomac River - and that's just the first day!

Day 2 starts as the sun comes up behind the Capitol, the Potomac River shoreline comes alive with activity: runners along Rock Creek Parkway and shell and kayak enthusiasts digging their oars into the river in the early morning mist. And it all makes a great picture.

Next we capture the magnificent Swedish Embassy in the early morning light, and the colorful Washington Harbour complex before trekking along Rock Creek Parkway up to the beautiful Arlington Memorial Bridge, with the sun shining through its arches.

Chris and David will share their experience and knowledge of the subjects as well as photographic skills and techniques to help you capture beautiful images. Learning and practicing to "get it right in the field" will save you much time on image processing.

Come sharpen your shooting and seeing skills (and learn new ones). Spend your days in the field learning to capture what you "see" and your evenings refining your image processing and editing skills and sharing each day's visual catch!

Meals and lodging are not included in the registration fee. However, we have secured a block of rooms with great rates at the Americana Hotel in Crystal City (Arlington), VA. Breakfast is complimentary at the hotel, and we will provide refreshments and snacks throughout the workshop.

With the workshop based in Arlington, VA, we'll have the advantage of being close to most of our locations. There will be no arduous hiking or strenuous walking. The workshop is designed for the beginner and advanced/intermediate level photographer.
